#### Case discussions, Tips&Tricks and Experience exchange

*Course 3 focusses on the technical aspects of interesting clinical cases. Two expert surgeons discuss 1-2 prepared cases, each that show a difficult situation that occurs during surgery (e.g. management of bleeding of the renal pedicle during lap. Nephrectomy) and how to manage this situation.*

*The cases are prepared by the tutors of the course and discussed with the participants of the course in an interactive way. Furthermore special tips & tricks are shown and/or discussed by the tutors. This leads to an experience exchange that is beneficial for every participant of the course.*

### Aims and objectives

The European Section of Uro-Technology (ESUT) and the EAU Section of Urolithiasis (EULIS) offer an intensive hands-on training course with different models focussing on the endoscopic management of urolithiasis. The delegates will be taken through a sequential programme of Ureterorenoscopy using normal endoscopic instruments in different models. The use of various guide-wires, baskets and intracorporeal lithotripters will be demonstrated. The ESUT and the

EULIS faculty consist of experienced surgeons in the field of Ureterorenoscopy. A video demonstrating the different steps and tasks of the procedures will be presented and afterwards the delegates will be instructed according to their level of experience in small teams at the models. Finally, all remaining questions can be answered and discussed with all tutors including the demonstration of tips and tricks.
